## About Telerad Foundation

The Telerad Foundation (TF) is Bengaluru-headquartered global not-for-profit social organization working to make high-quality healthcare accessible and affordable to people everywhere, regardless of their geography and economic status. ## About the Project:

The Phygital PHC Telemedicine Project combines telehealth and on-ground healthcare to serve rural and underserved communities. Since Jan 2022, it has delivered over 260,758 telehealth consultations, 9,459 screenings for eye & breast health, and 107,212 NCD screenings. Phase 2 expands across 20 telehealth facilities in Maharashtra, Gujarat, Karnataka, Uttar Pradesh, and Assam, serving 1.5 million people. Key focus areas include NCD management, nutrition, early detection of cancers, vector-borne disease prevention, and health awareness.

## Work Location, Timing & Reporting:

You will be based at one of the two state dispensaries in Majuli district: Rangachahi or Bongaon state dispensaries. Work will follow a general shift, with weekly offs aligned to the State Dispensary schedule. You will coordinate closely with the Medical Officer (MO) and senior staff at the dispensary and report to your assigned Telerad Foundation manager based in Bengaluru.

## Key Responsibilities:

### *Clinical:*

- Patient registration, assisting doctors, dispensing medicines
- Conducting tests, camps, and home visits
- Maintaining online OPD records
- Health education sessions (reproductive health, HIV/AIDS, adolescent health)
- Referring patients to specialists and participating in health melas



#### *Outreach:*

- Social/resource mapping, distributing IEC materials & healthcare products
- Building rapport with beneficiaries, local leaders, and authorities

#### *Administrative:*

- Coordinate with PHCs, CHCs, PRI members, and other stakeholders
- Ensure project deliverables, organize BCC events, supervise telehealth center
- Maintain records, monthly reports, legal/compliance documents
- Adhere to SOPs and report online on time
- Other tasks assigned by management or doctors
